The plan:

- Recruiting of youth cohort
 - Young people from 93706
 - Developing curriculum and programming
 - Empowering youth to serve as ambassadors for TCC programs
 - Creating a toolkit for youth inclusion across TCC
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Preparing a cohort of 12 youth to engage with Transform Fresno projects and community events & meetings

What does this look like?

- Building content knowledge of our youth cohort by inviting community leaders and organizations that were involved in developing
- Incentivize with stipend as well as opportunities for leadership development and community engagement
- Connecting youth to projects in TCC through partners who work with, such as the garden program at Sunset Community Center
- Training our young people to do outreach to invite community residents to the quarterly community meetings and annual summit

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Development of curriculum and program

- Co-developed with youth and adult partners from BMOOC and Street Saints
 - Four young people to lead development of curriculum
- Cohort to meet and be trained at Edison School High School
 - intended launch with orientation at beginning of 2020-21 school year
