





- TCC Funding Awarded (January 2018)
- City of Fresno HOME Program Funding Awarded & TCC Sub-Agreement Approved (October 2019)
- Applied for 4% CTCAC Application (November 2019)
- 4% CTCAC Awarded (January 2020)

- California Energy Funding (February 2020)
 - Project will include:
 - Solar
 - Will Offset all Residential Utility Costs
 - Free Bus Passes for Residents
 - Electric Vehicle Charging Stations
 - Drought Tolerant Landscaping
 - Bike Storage Lockers

Urban Greening & Active Transportation Improvements In Chinatown Area

- STI #1 will improve active transportation access to a transit stop in Chinatown located on F and Tulare Streets through the installation of 14 LED streetlights on F Street. Lighting will be installed from Fresno to Ventura Street.
- STI #2 will increase the urban tree canopy and provide more greenspace in Chinatown. This will be accomplished through planting 26 trees on F Street from Fresno to Mariposa Streets.
- STI #3 will reconstruct China Alley between Kern and Inyo into a permeable green alley and install strand lighting to increase visibility.
