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WFATT Program


West Fresno Advanced Transportation Technology Training (WFATT)

- **Enrollment:** 200 participants over entire grant period.
- Training: Participants will complete 160 hours of low emissions truck driver training at United Truck Driving.
- Placement: Assistance in job placement in trucking industry.

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Progress

- January 2018 Transformative Climate Communities Grant Approved.
- February 2020 WFATT Contract Approved.
- May 2020 Finalized budgets for subcontractors.
- October 2020 Pre-screening, eligibility, and enrollments.
- March 2021 Five (5) Participants enrolled. Four (4) ready to start Truck Driver Training.
- May 2021 Projected start date for Truck Driver Training.
