Park at MLK Magnet Core

As part of the California Strategic Growth Council's Transformative Climate Communities (TCC) grant program, Fresno was one of three cities identified to receive grant funds to pilot community-led project planning targeting improvement projects benefiting disadvantage communities. Identified projects intend to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and provide local environmental, health, economic, and social equity benefits. One such 'Urban Greening' project is the design and construction of a 10-acre public park to serve the community of southwest Fresno. The park, which will be built within an approved 120 acre Master Development project called "West Creek Village", is currently identified by Transform Fresno as <u>Project #13 Park at MLK Magnet</u> <u>Core</u>.
