Drive Clean in the San Joaquin Replace Program







How the Program Works...



The Drive Clean in the San Joaquin replace program will help replace your older vehicle with a newer, cleaner model!

You can receive up to \$9,500 for the retirement of a vehicle that is 2006 or older, by replacing it with a newer vehicle that is 2015 or newer and that also meet certain criteria.


















Which vehicles can be retired and replaced?

- The current vehicle must be:
 - Currently operational
 - Gasoline-powered
 - Model year 2006 or older
- The vehicle must have been owned by you for at least 6 months.
- The vehicle must have proof of use within California for the past 2 years.

Which areas of California does this program cover?

The Participant must reside within the jurisdiction of the <u>San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District</u>

- Fresno County
- Kern County (partial)
- Kings County
- Madera County
- Merced County
- •San Joaquin County
- Stanislaus County
- Tulare County



There are income requirements for qualification for this program

The participant needs to be at or below 400% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) to qualify, with the incentive increasing as household income decreases.

We use the annual income and number of people living in your household to calculate the incentive amount.

If the participant is at or below 225% of FPL according to the chart, the participant can receive the maximum incentive amount.

Requirements for replacement vehicles include:

- Model year 2015 or newer
- Less than 100,000 miles on the odometer ideally less than 80,000 miles
- Finance rate not to exceed 15.99%
- No active vehicle safety recalls

Here's what you need to share with us to qualify:

- 1. 2 years of vehicle registration (2020 through present if you have it)
- 2. 2 years of vehicle insurance
 (2020 through present if you have it)
- 3. Vehicle Title
 - → You must have owned your vehicle for at least 6 months
 - → Needs to be under your name for at least 6 months
- 4. First 2 pages of 2020 1040 tax return
 - \rightarrow You can cover the SSN, we don't need it
- 5. First page of current PG&E or SoCal Edison bill
 - → It does not have to be under your name
- 6. Valid CA Driver's License

What is EVSE and what additional incentive can participants qualify for?

Qualified customers purchasing plug-in electric vehicles (Plug-In Hybrid Electric Vehicle (PHEV) or Battery Electric Vehicle (BEV)) from the Drive Clean in the San Joaquin Vehicle Replacement program may receive an additional \$2,000 towards purchase and installation of Electric Vehicle Service Equipment (EVSE).

The incentive will be available for the purchase and installation of EVSE, commonly referred to as EV charging equipment, at their single-family residence and potentially multi-family residence.
