

# LAGERSTROEMIA INDICA x 'NATCHEZ' CRAPE MYRTLE



- DECIDUOUS
- DROUGHT TOLERANT ONCE ESTABLISHED
- SUN EXPOSURE: PARTIAL SHADE TO FULL SUN
- TREE SHAPE: ROUNDED OR VASE
- MAXIMUM TREE HEIGHT: 30 FEET CANOPY WIDTH: 15-25 FEET
- GROWTH RATE: ~12-24 in/year
- LONGEVITY: GREATER THAN 100 YEARS
- LEAF/LEAFLET: OVAL
- LEAF COLOR: BRONZE OR PURPLE OR REDDISH
- FALL COLOR: YES
- FLOWER COLOR: WHITE
- FLOWERING TIME: JUNE TO SEPTEMBER
- LITTER: DRY FRUIT
- TRUNK: STRIKING, LIGHT GREEN, PINK OR RED BROWN, EXFOLIATING, SMOOTH BARK
- PREFERS WELL DRAINED SOIL
- SOILS: LOAM, SAND, CLAY
- SHADING CAPACITY RATED AS MODERATE



# CEDRUS DEODORA- DEODAR CEDAR



- EVERGREEN
- DROUGHT TOLERANT
- EXPOSURE: FULL SUN TO PARTIAL SHADE
- SPREADING OR WEEPING
- REQUIRES AMPLE GROWING SPACE
- SHAPE: CONICAL
- HEIGHT: 40 - 60 FEET
- WIDTH: 20 - 30 FEET
- GROWTH RATE: 36 INCHES PER YEAR
- LONGEVITY: GREATER THAN 150 YEARS
- LITTER ISSUE IS DRY FRUIT
- LEAVES: NEEDLE, BLUE GREEN OR MEDIUM GREEN
- FLOWERS BROWN CONE, VERY LARGE (OVER 3.00 INCHES), FRUITING IN SPRING
- BARK: DARK GRAY, FISSURED
- SHADING CAPACITY RATED AS MODERATE TO DENSE IN LEAF



# QUERCUS LOBATA- VALLEY OAK

- EVERGREEN
- EXPOSURE: FULL SUN TO PARTIAL SHADE
- ERECT, SPREADING OR WEeping
- REQUIRES AMPLE GROWING SPACE.
- SHAPE :OVAL, ROUNDED OR UMBRELLA
- HEIGHT: 50 - 70 FEET
- WIDTH: 50 FEET
- GROWTH RATE: 24 TO 36 INCHES PER YEAR
- LONGEVITY: GREATER THAN 150 YEARS
- LEAVES: OBOVATE AND LOBED, MEDIUM TO DARK GREEN, BRONZE OR GOLD
- PROLIFIC, BROWN ACORN, MEDIUM (0.50 - 1.50 INCHES), FRUITING IN FALL OR WINTER
- BARK: DARK BROWN, LIGHT GRAY OR LIGHT GREEN, BLOCKY OR FURROWED
- SHADING CAPACITY RATED AS MODERATE IN LEAF AND OUT OF LEAF
- LITTER ISSUE IS DRY FRUIT
- DESIRABLE WILDLIFE PLANT
- ATTRACTS BIRDS & SQUIRRELS
- RIPARIAN



# QUERCUS COCCINEA- SCARLET OAK

- DECIDUOUS
  - EXPOSURE: FULL SUN TO PARTIAL SHADE
  - ERECT OR SPREADING
  - REQUIRES AMPLE GROWING SPACE
  - SHAPE: OVAL, ROUNDED OR UMBRELLA
  - HEIGHT: 70 FEET
  - WIDTH: 50 FEET
  - GROWTH RATE: 24 TO 36 INCHES PER YEAR
  - LONGEVITY: GREATER THAN 150 YEARS
  - LEAVES: ELLIPTIC AND LOBED, GLOSSY MEDIUM GREEN, BRONZE, RED,
- ORANGE OR MULTICOLORED, DECIDUOUS
  - BROWN ACORN, MEDIUM (0.50 - 1.50 INCHES), FRUITING IN FALL OR WINTER
  - BARK: BLACK OR DARK BROWN, FURROWED, SCALY OR SMOOTH
  - SHADING CAPACITY RATED AS MODERATE IN LEAF AND OUT OF LEAF
  - LITTER ISSUE IS DRY FRUIT
  - DESIRABLE WILDLIFE PLANT
  - ATTRACTS BIRDS AND SQUIRRELS
